




Total CSF Network Funding

Individual Training Accounts 2017/18 Waiver Policy

- Statutorily required to allocate 50 percent of Adult and Dislocated Worker expenditures to Individual Training Accounts
- Sliding Scale developed based on budget reductions since 2012/13
- LWDBs may request a one-year continuation waiver
- Waivers granted at request of LWDBs at any amount above lowest possible percentage
