



CAREERSOURCE FLORIDA INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Purpose

- To provide a mutually beneficial experience for the intern and CareerSource Florida.
- To support CareerSource Florida's goals and objectives.

Eligibility

- Must have junior or senior standing and be currently enrolled in a four-year degree program; or
- Enrolled in the last semester of a two-year degree program; or
- Enrolled in a graduate program; or
- Enrolled in college-level coursework and have special measurable technical skills.

Time Commitment and Work Parameters

Internships have a start and end date for a period not to exceed six months. Internships may be extended up to an additional six months based on management recommendation and approval.

Evaluation of Interns

All interns will receive a work and learning plan with specific objectives and expectations. Interns will be provided ongoing feedback on how well they are meeting the requirements of the program. An evaluation will be conducted upon completion of the internship.

Compensation

CareerSource Florida offers for-credit and paid internships. The position posting will identify the internship compensation status.

Application Requirements

All interns must consent to an application process, pre-employment screening and reference check requirements as a condition of employment.
