Overview of Labor Market Estimating Conference Data

- Conference convened Oct. 25, 2022
- Summary of adopted product
 - Wage information by occupation
 - Occupations in undersupply identified within occupations requiring non-degree postsecondary credentials and associates degrees
 - Wage and undersupply aggregated for state and all 24 local workforce development board areas

CAPE (Career and Professional Education) Funding Eligibility

- Application window open Nov. 1 30, 2022 before
 Committee adopts a definition of Credentials of Value
- Applications for both K-12 and postsecondary industry certifications will be accepted
- Allows more time for evaluation of new industry certification

CAPE Funding Eligibility

- Industry certifications on the existing Master
 Credentials List do not need to submit an application
- Industry certifications collected as part of the Credentials Review Committee workgroups do not need to submit an application
- Must align with a Standard Occupation Classification code identified in either the Labor Market Estimating Conference product as one in undersupply or on any of the 2020-21, 2021-22, or 2022-23 Regional Demand Occupation Lists

November	11/1 to 11/30 – Application window open for submission of certifications to be considered for state CAPE Act funding for the 2022-2023 school year.
	Mid-November – Agenda packet for December Credentials Review Committee meeting provided to committee members for review.

Timeline Review

December	12/7 – Credentials Review Committee meeting to approve final Framework of Quality criteria and introduce postsecondary performance funding.
	 Initial evaluation of existing credentials using approved Framework of Quality begins. Evaluation of industry certifications submitted in the November CAPE application window continues using approved Framework of Quality.

Timeline Review

February 2023	On or near 2/9 – Credentials Review Committee meets to adopt Master Credentials List for state of Florida.
	On or near 2/10 – Application window for credentials <i>not</i> included in initial evaluation for Master Credentials List opens.
	TBD – CareerSource Florida Board meeting to approve delivery of Master Credentials List to State Board of Education.
March 2023	3/22 – State Board of Education meets and votes on CAPE Industry Certification List.
