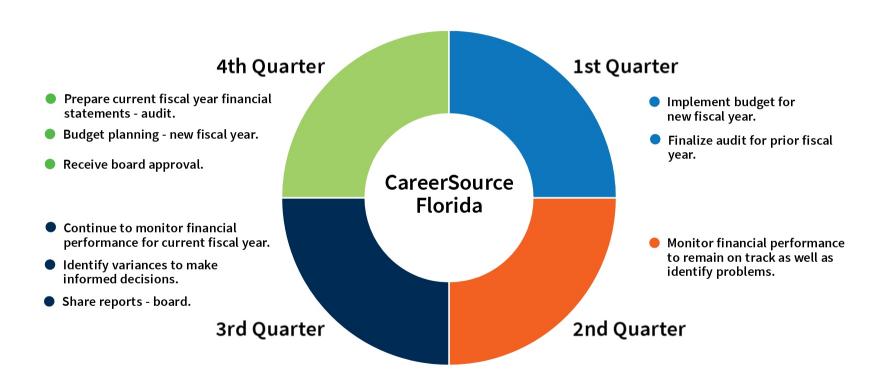

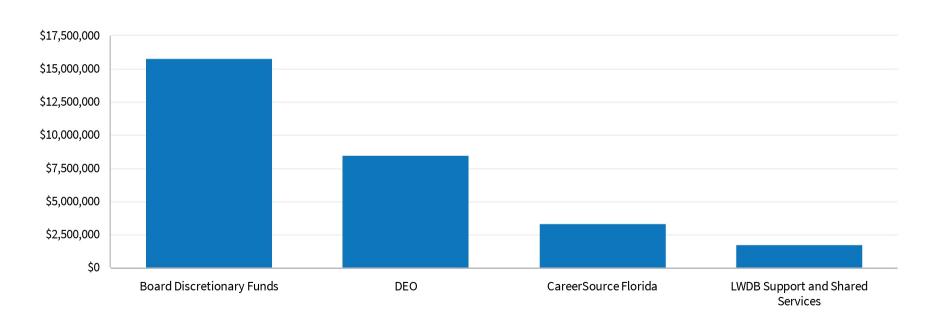
2023-2024 WIOA Funds \$122,195,108

- State Set-Aside: \$18,329,264
- Rapid Response: \$10,710,896
- Local Allocations: \$93,154,948

Board Discretionary Funds

Hope Navigators - each LWDB

Military Family Employment Advocacy Navigators - LWDBs near military bases

Apprenticeship Navigators - each LWDB

Additional Navigator support as needed (Substance Abuse and Reentry, Broadband Infrastructure, etc.)
