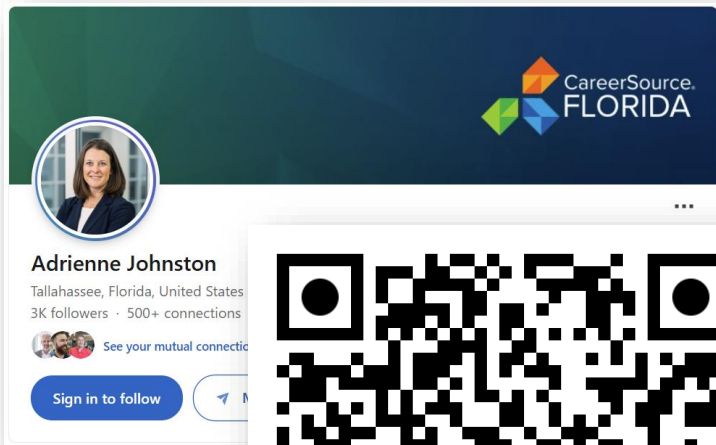

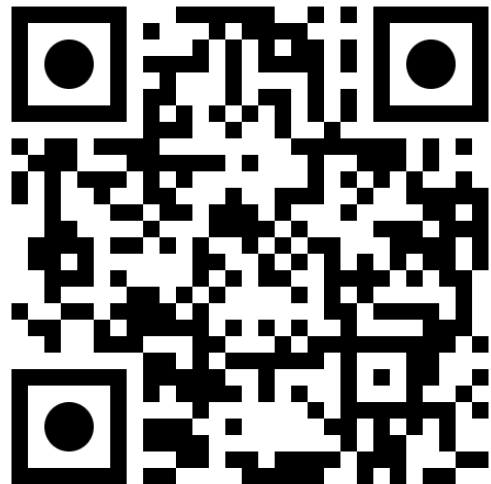

Workforce Policy 03 - Sector Strategies, Targeted Occupations, and Education and Industry Consortiums

- **Combines** sector strategies, local targeted occupations lists (TOL), and education and industry consortium requirements.
- **Requires** each LWDB to implement employer-led sector strategies, maintain a TOL, and appoint an education and industry consortium to guide workforce and education alignment.
- **Aligns** workforce, education, and economic development efforts to support a demand-driven workforce system.
- **Advances** industry-driven decision-making, integrated partnerships, talent pipelines, and measurable outcomes for businesses and job seekers.

Local Planning Updates

- Regional and Local WIOA plans are required by federal law.
- Local Performance Negotiations Webinar for LWDBs is being scheduled.
- LWDB WIOA Planning Guidelines to be released to boards by FloridaCommerce on July 15, 2026
- Local boards have TWO options:

Combined Regional Plan	Single Local Plan
One combined plan coordinated with their local planning region partners with separate addendums for each LWDB on performance. DUE January 19, 2027	A separate local plan with the required regional plans added as an addendum. DUE October 16, 2026
