RECOMMENDATION TO SUNSET THREE CAREERSOURCE FLORIDA STRATEGIC AND ADMINISTRATIVE POLICIES

The CareerSource Florida Board of Directors serves as the principal workforce policy organization for the state as described in Chapter 445.004(2), Florida Statutes. The state board establishes and directs the vision for the state workforce system. The state workforce development board may delegate the performance of any duties or the exercise of any powers to such officers and agents as the board may from time to time, designate by resolution.

CareerSource Florida and the Florida Department of Commerce (FloridaCommerce) reviews policies for their effectiveness and efficiency and recommend the recission of policies, as necessary.

CareerSource Florida Policy 2013.08.29.A.1 – Performance Incentives Policy was approved by the CareerSource Florida Board of Directors on August 29, 2013, to establish annual performance incentives aligned with the strategic goals of the CareerSource Florida Board of Directors. The policy aimed to recognize and reward local workforce development boards for their efforts and outcomes. The CareerSource Florida network no longer distributes performance incentives, and this policy is now obsolete. All performance measures are negotiated and included in Appendix 1 of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Combined Plan.

CareerSource Florida Administrative Policy 68 – Reemployment and Eligibility Assessment (REA) Program offered information and operational guidance on providing services to Reemployment Assistance claimants. The policy is obsolete and will be replaced by the new Administrative Policy – Reemployment Services and Eligibility Assessment (RESEA) Program Design and Framework.

CareerSource Florida Administrative Policy – FG – OSPS 89 Employed and Incumbent Worker Training, developed in 2016, updated the requirements and restrictions for Employed Worker and Incumbent Worker Training (IWT) provided by local workforce development boards. This policy is obsolete and is replaced by the revised Workforce Policy 100 – Work-based Training and Work-based Learning Opportunities.

CareerSource Florida and FloridaCommerce recommend the sunset of these three policies and their removal from the CareerSource Florida Policy Portfolio.
